




CERT Con 2016

Lost Person

- Who is reporting? Relationship?
- Describe missing person: Name, age, gender, race, height/ weight/build, clothing color/style/hat etc, hair color/eye color.
- Special Considerations: Medical or Behavioral?
- Last seen WHEN AND WHERE (how long missing).
- Actions taken prior to contact with CERT Call, search, etc.
- Cell Phone Number?
- Relevant history.


Public Safety officials urge all residents and business owners to determine which Police District stations are closest to them in the event of an emergency.
