
The videos were professionally produced and include footage of actual CERT Rodeo training they conducted.





Organizational News



GO-TEAM REVIEW



Team Organization

- Teams of two
- Each group of teams must have a manager (aka leader team)
 - i.e. in a group of 8 there would be six 2 person teams and one 2 person leader team (designed to act as floor/zone manager)
- Radio is issued only to skilled team member who
 - Carefully positions their radio to be heard in a noisy area
 - listens; can uses ear piece; only talks when called or in an emergency
 - Always speaks in clear, crisp, clean, tones
 - Is careful to avoid accidental transmissions ("open-mic")



Individual Gear

- Each member must have the following:
 - Sturdy shoes or boots with tread; long pants; uniform shirt
 - CERT issued VEST; Gloves; appropriate outer wear
 - Includes CERT cap, hat, or helmet; standard issue PPE
 - Two light sources (i.e. Head lamp & flashlight or light sticks)
 - Whistle of emergency signaling
 - Something to write on and with (i.e.: notebook and pencil)
 - Individual first aid kit (to treat themselves)
 - Basic first aid supplies to treat bleeding on a patient; gloves



Leader Gear

- Each *leader* team must have the following:
 - All "member gear" (as previous)
 - Radio (when issued or personally owned)
 - Map; sketch of the area; note important details from brief
 - Exact count of your members, their names
 - Last known location of each member (for PARS)



Team Gear

(issued at Rally Point)

- Issued by logistics at rally point:
 - Radios
 - Bull horn
 - Tarps and litters (as needed)
 - First Aid supplies
 - Bandages; dressings; splints; etc
 - Incident specific items (flags; tape; "green dots"; forms)



Deployable Go-Team Review

Notification:

Via email &/or SMS message; must have SMS text box checked to get messages

• Respond:

ACK to dispatch; get to address within 90 '(NO negative replies needed)

Rally:

- At a given address slightly away from the site within 90 minutes
- May have to walk or carpool into actual location
- Must be in teams with team gear (i.e. radios, "marking media", whistle) issued
- Must identify team leads prior to moving out

Report to the IC:

 Stand attentively, orderly, and in formation while CERT Command gets assignment from IC



Deployable Go-Team Review (continued)

Remediate

- Address the problem you came to help with; stay alert & safe
- Remain professional; stay focused; report as requested

Return:

- Return to your vehicles when assignment is complete
- Text dispatch to say you are "in quarters" (aka home)
- Make notes for after action review
 - Adjust your equipment, supplies, sundries so you'll be ready for next time
